It was a year ago that I was in the hospital for the first time in my life. The minor surgery meant that I had to stay overnight. When it came time for the dressing change the next day, I thought that I was going to die from the intense pain. Of course my brief experience of pain was nothing compared to the chronic conditions or acute illnesses that so many people suffer each and every day. When you think of all the people in hospitals or nursing homes, and the countless others around the world who endure without any medical care, the enormity of suffering seems overwhelming.

It is no wonder then that in Jesus' time once the crowds had heard that he cured Simon's mother-in-law, they raced to bring to him all who were ill or possessed by demons. If someone could alleviate the pain, cure the sick, and cast out demons this was definitely an opportunity of which to take advantage.

While modern medicine may help us with our physical illness and psychological pain, there is still a spiritual dimension to sickness that we should not ignore. Sickness separates us. It makes us question our faith. Illness strikes at our heart as well as our body. That is why the church offers the sacrament of the anointing of the sick for any who are ill. When we are sick, we are also alone. We need the support of the community of faith. And we need their prayers.

When a loved one is ill-or if you are sick yourself-don't hesitate to request the sacrament of anointing. If your illness confines you for a longer time, ask to receive Communion regularly to nurture you spiritually even as you seek to be strengthened physically. People sought out Jesus in this weekend's Gospel. When we or a loved one is ill, we can seek him out today.

Conforme va avanzando el año litúrgico es bueno que recordemos que el Ciclo B nos pone en contacto con el Evangelio de Marcos. Éste es el más corto con tan solo 16 capítulos y escrito alrededor del año 70, probablemente en Roma. San Marcos nos narra historias y hechos que determinan la vida de Jesús. A él se le atribuye el género literario conocido como Evangelio, seguido luego por Mateo y Lucas.

Veamos, pues, qué mensaje nos brindan las lecturas de este domingo. Si escuchamos detenidamente la lectura del Libro de Job, nos daremos cuenta de que tal pareciera que él narra nuestra propia vida. Job se siente sin esperanza, como un jornalero, soldado, y esclavo que suspira para que llegue la hora del descanso. Es un retrato de nuestra vida cotidiana como inmigrantes trabajando siempre llenos de sufrimientos y desengaños, preguntándonos muchas veces, ¿cuándo terminara todo esto? ¿Cuándo veré la luz? Sin embargo, en las frases finales Job recuerda que Dios es el que nos puede ayudar y darnos esperanza. Claro está, si confiamos que el timan del barco lo lleva siempre Dios.

Para nosotros ahora es diferente que en los tiempos de Job, ya que tenemos al Señor Jesús que comparte y entiende nuestras cargas y sufrimientos. Por eso nos dice: "Vengan a mí, todos los que están fatigados y agobiados por la carga, y yo los aliviaré" (Mateo 11:28). Reflexionemos sobre el sufrimiento del mundo y oremos para que nuestros corazones sean compasivos tal como el Sagrado Corazón de Jesús. ¡Que se acabe la violencia que destruye familias, comunidades, y pueblos enteros! ¿Estamos dispuestos a cooperar para esta causa?
